To fill your Parker "51"...



- a. Remove cap and unscrew barrel at metal ring.
- b. Follow instructions engraved on silvery inner barrel.
- c. After filling, hold pen *point-down*, and press cleansing tissue or any absorbent material around pen point to remove excess ink.



How to operate your Parker "51" Continuous Feed Pencil

1. TO EXTEND LEAD...

Hold pencil point down. Press and release top of pencil until desired length of lead shows. Leads feed automatically.

2. TO RELOAD...

Remove metal cap and eraser. Insert no more than 12 Parker Writefine short leads— $1\frac{3}{8}$ " long.

3. TO AVOID LEAD "JAMS"...

Occasionally inspect magazine for broken leads, and remove them. Be sure to use only Parker Writefine short leads. Do not allow lead chamber to become empty.

4. TO REGULATE ERASER LENGTH...

Slide adjustable collar up or down on eraser.
